

2017 IDITAROD RESTART

Race details: The race will start at 11 a.m. Monday, March 6, on Hoselton Road near Pike's Waterfront Lodge.

Spectator viewing, parking and shuttle details: Spectator viewing areas will be available at Pike's Waterfront Lodge and Pike's Landing Restaurant. (These can be accessed via the free shuttle buses from the Carlson Center.)

Free shuttle buses will run from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. between the Carlson Center and the Pike's Landing/Pike's Waterfront Lodge area. Shuttle parking is available at the Carlson Center back parking lot, Growden Park and the Moore Street parking lot near Pioneer Park.

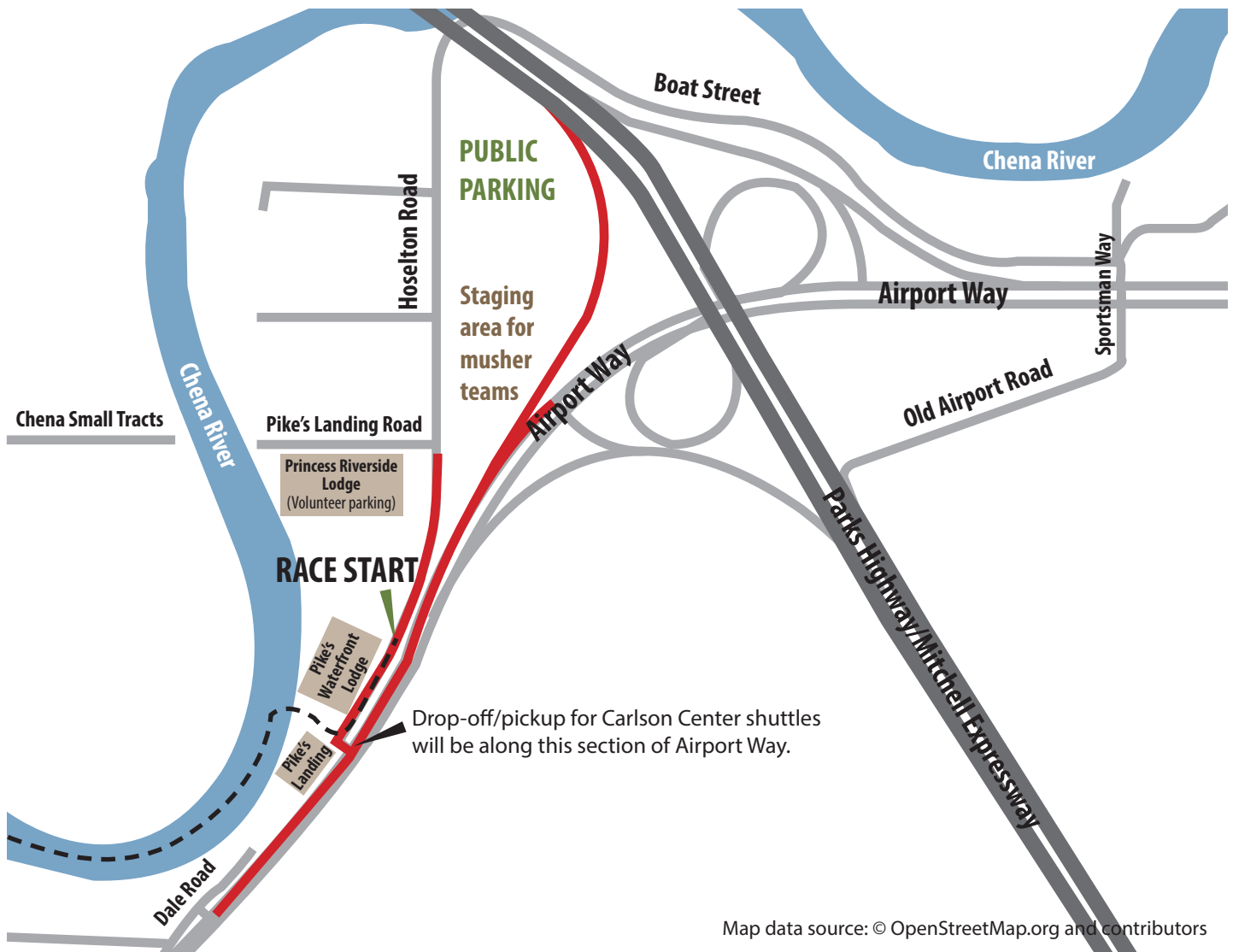
Extremely limited spectator parking will be available at Journey Christian Church on Hoselton Road. This lot can only be accessed by taking Sportsman Way to Boat Street to Hoselton Road. Access to the church parking lot will be closed when the lot is full. **NO PARKING ALONG AIRPORT WAY.** Alaska State Troopers and

Fairbanks airport police will provide traffic control.

For those planning to watch the race on the other side of the river, spectator parking will be available at The Pump House parking lot (Note: The restaurant will not be open.) and at the Chena Pump wayside. *No parking will be allowed along Chena Pump Road.* Parking restrictions will be enforced.

Lane closure details: Airport Way will be closed to public traffic westbound past the Mitchell Expressway ramps to Dale Road. Buses, taxis and borough Van Tran will still have access to Airport Way westbound.

Airport access details: For access to Fairbanks International Airport (FAI), Airport Post Office (99706), Alaska Airlines Cargo and businesses along Airport Industrial Road, take University Avenue South to the "East Ramp" and drive around the airport. There will be no lane closure for traffic traveling east on Airport Way from FAI; however, airport police will monitor traffic closely near Pike's.
