Below is a statement from Iditarod Trail Committee race marshal Mark Nordman with regard to DeeDee Jonrowe's (bib #45) spot tracker:

When Iditarod veteran musher DeeDee Jonrowe (bib #45) was changing to a different sled at the Takotna checkpoint, she inadvertently forgot to transfer her spot trackers to her new sled. Due to this, Jonrowe's GPS location at Iditarod.com shows that she is still at the Takotna checkpoint. Race marshal Mark Nordman confirmed that Jonrowe has left the Ophir checkpoint and is en route to the Cripple checkpoint. The Iditarod Air Force will deliver her spot trackers to the Cripple checkpoint, where they will then be attached to her sled upon arrival.
