52 mushers enter Iditarod XLV on opening day

Wasilla, Alaska – Today, 29 mushers were on location at Iditarod Trail Committee headquarters in Wasilla to officially enter the 2017 Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race. Another 23 signed up by mail, rounding out the total to 52 mushers officially entered on the first official entry day for the 45th running of the Iditarod.

Of the 52 opening day entries, 12 registered as rookies. 10 teams hail from countries outside the United States, including Canada, England, France, Hungary, New Zealand, Norway and Sweden, and 4 states outside of Alaska (Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota and Montana) are represented.

Current and four-time champion Dallas Seavey; four-time champions Jeff King, Martin Buser and Lance Mackey; and two-time champion Mitch Seavey, along with a talented group of top finishers promise to make the 45th running of the Iditarod every bit as competitive as any race in history.

During the opening day festivities, the Iditarod also paid tribute to the hundreds of volunteers who were on hand by hosting its annual volunteer appreciation picnic. Race sponsor Golden Corral provided a catered lunch, and race sponsor PenAir flew in fresh sockeye salmon from Bristol Bay.

Each year, two mushers are randomly drawn at the end of the volunteer appreciation picnic to receive a complimentary entry fee into the race. Veteran musher Cindy Abbott of Willow, Alaska, and veteran musher Mike Suprenant of Chugiak, Alaska were this year's winners.

Mushers wishing to enter the 45th Iditarod have until the close of business on Thursday, Dec. 1, to turn in their entries. It is expected that the starting field will approach 80 teams.
