Below is a statement from Iditarod Trail Committee race director Mark Nordman with regard to Robert Redington (bib #57):

The Iditarod Trail Committee is adjusting Iditarod XLIV musher Robert Redington's (bib #57) overall mandatory stop time due to a miscalculation on his 24-hour layover at the Nikolai checkpoint. At no fault of Redington, he was inadvertently allowed to depart the checkpoint 50 minutes before the actual conclusion of his layover. The Iditarod Trail Committee advised Redington that the 50 minutes will be added on to the eight-hour layover on the Yukon River to even out the stop time mandatory for all mushers. This adjustment does not affect Redington's overall race time or provide any competitive advantage or disadvantage over other racers.
