Iditarod XLVII prize money by finishing position

Anchorage, Alaska – With the final finisher crossing under the burlled arch in Nome at 1:51 p.m. today, the Iditarod Trail Committee is able to announce the official breakdown of the \$500,000 race purse by finishing position. This breakdown is determined based on the total number of finishers (39).

In 2017, the ITC Board of Directors made the decision to revert back to paying out the top 20 finishers with the largest portion of the purse. Mushers who finished Iditarod XLVII in 21st place and below will receive \$1,049.

Below is a chart that details the prize money for places 1-20, as well as the customary \$1,049 payment for places 21-39, totaling \$500,000.
